Re: The Small Business Innovation Research Program and Relevant Rule Changes


Dear Administrator Barreto:

Just to formalize staff conversations over the past couple of months regarding the Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) program, I ask that you expedite finalizing the rule regarding wholly-owned subsidiaries and put out for public comment SBA's recent clarification of the rule regarding the ownership of a small businesses by individuals. As you know, the latter renders ineligible SBIR applicants that are owned by venture capital firms that themselves are not small businesses by definition. Both venture-owned and non-venture owned SBIR companies are eager to voice their concerns about this clarification, and I believe it is in the best interest of the program and the businesses it is intended to serve to make sure all sides are heard.

Both of these rules are extremely important to the small businesses that compete for research and development awards and grants through the SBIR program, and I ask that the SBA act immediately. Please respond in writing by next Friday, October 24<sup>th</sup>, about the schedule for these two requests.
